Group History

Lumpkin Street Noontimers began as a meeting in 1992. It was started in order to offer an alternative to the noon meeting at the old Cobb House, which was becoming very crowded at the time. The first meeting was held at the University of Georgia Catholic Center, 1344 South Lumpkin Street, across from the UGA campus. Dee W. and John R. filled out the paperwork for Group status and submitted it to the General Service Office on June 18, 1993. The meeting became a registered group with Alcoholics Anonymous on July 16, 1993.

After a change in leadership at the Catholic Center and the need for renovation of the building, it was decided that the group should move to a new location. So, in 2002, the group moved to the Presbyterian Student Center, also on Lumpkin Street. The group stayed at the Presbyterian Student Center for three years until the decision was made to move a few doors up the street to the Campus View Church of Christ at 1360 South Lumpkin Street. Since late 2005, the group has met there. Past GSR's have included Dee W., Ross M., Melissa S., Mike M., Dick D., Tim H. (the elder), Patrick M., Wilma H., Jim T., and Tim H. (the younger).

Meetings are held from 12:10 PM - 1:00 PM on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday every week, with the Wednesday meeting being an open discussion. Mondays and Fridays are closed discussion meetings. Birthdays are generally celebrated on the last Friday of each month and are speaker meetings. The first Monday each month is a Step Study, corresponding to the number of the month, while the third Monday each month is a Tradition study.
